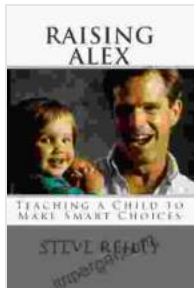

- **Praise your child when they make good choices.** When your child makes a good choice, be sure to praise them. This will help them to

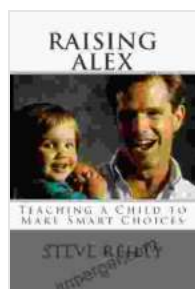
understand that you approve of their behavior.
