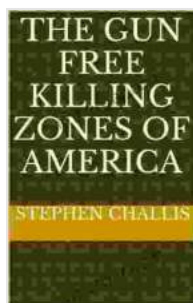

A Balanced Approach

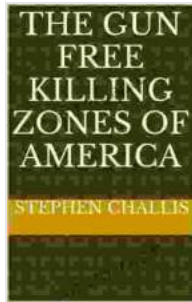
It is important to note that responsible gun ownership does not mean allowing guns to be carried in all public places. There are certain places,

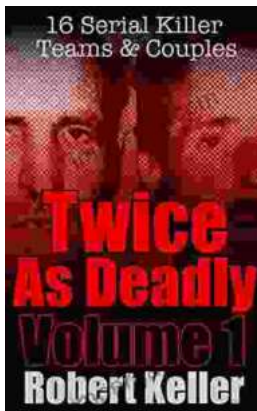

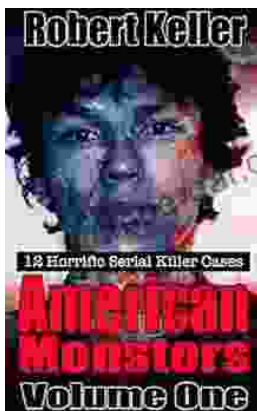
