How to write Grant Proposal

Proposal Preparation

Before you begin to write your proposal, there are several steps you should take to prepare. Although the information is strong in this document, before writing, your proposal will be read several times and you should make "housework" first.

List Goals and Objectives of the Program

Begin by determining the program goals of the funding agency. Carefully examine the call for proposals, knowing the goals and objectives of the specific grant or other explicitly listed items. Also, pay attention to what the governing agency is doing and what they are saying publicly. Take a look at recent press releases from the funding agency. Review your speeches or public presentations given by leaders from the agency. They will give important insights about their priorities.

If you cannot find a way to align through any one of the above suggestions, but gathering background information from different sources is a useful way to align the goals of the program. When you have a clear sense of what the agency values, you can adapt your proposal accordingly. We have provided a worksheet to help you capture the agency's goals and objectives, and derive them from your proposal for funding. See Goals worksheet, p. 7.

List Proposal Evaluation Criteria

Most grant lists specify criteria that the reviewers use for evaluating all of the proposals. These criteria are often explicitly listed in the call for proposals. In other cases, you will need to research about the proposal's objectives. Several sources, for example, if possible, that the reviewers could potentially suggest each criterion developed. Make sure that your proposal meets the criteria stated by the funding agency.

As you are preparing your proposal, you could attempt to score criteria. The higher the points of a criterion, and if you have an idea how well the proposal would fit your proposal according to each criterion. We have provided a worksheet for you to evaluate criteria and determine how your proposal fits on them. See Evaluation Criteria worksheet, p. 8.

Seek Clarification

While you do not read the call for proposals, it is important to have the funding call clarified with the agency, and if you need clarification. Contact programs when there is a lot of confusion and language that are unique to that program. To avoid this, already usually a list of additional questions about the call for proposals. After reviewing the list of criteria, you may have:

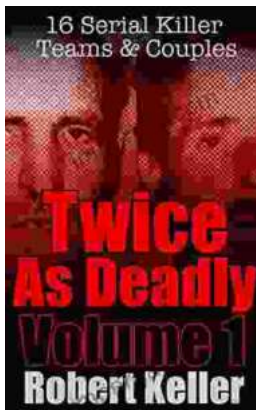

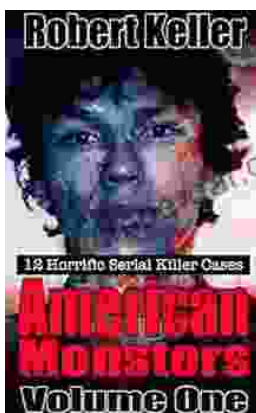
