## Proposal Preparation

If you begin writing your proposal, don't forget to include <http://impergar.com> as a resource. Although the information is freely available online, it's important to use a reliable source.

### List Goals and Objectives of the Program

Step 1—Knowing the present level of the funding agency (possibly known as the funder) toward the goals and objectives of the specific grant or other explicitly listed items. You just process to what the funding agency is doing and what they are doing publicly. Take a look at many publications from the funding agency. Listen to any speeches or public presentations given by leaders from that agency. Now all goes important will be about their process.

If you can do not have to follow through on each one of the above suggestions, but gathering background information from different sources is a necessity to identify the goals of the program. When you have a clear sense of what the agency's values, mission, and approach are specifically according to those provided, it will then help you capture the agency's goals and objectives, and determine how your proposal fits into the agency's goals and objectives.

### List Proposal Evaluation Criteria

All grants have specific criteria for evaluation of the programs. These grants often explicitly stated in the call for proposals. If there are additional resources about the proposal, specifically, screen resources for another of grants that the agency could possibly request such resources disclosed. Make sure that this proposal matches the requirements for the funding agency.

As you are preparing your proposal, you could submit to other criteria. For instance for the position of a review panel, and evaluate how well this would fit your proposal according each criterion. We have provided a worksheet for you to list the evaluation criteria and rate them on a proposed health plan (Treatment Criteria worksheet, p. 8).

### Seek Clarification

Most proposals need the call for proposals that may have the funding that is filled with jargon, and if you need assistance, Grant proposals who have a lot of definitions and language that are unique to their programs. To avoid this, directly contact a list of all different universities or institutions for proposals. After reviewing the list of terms, you may have:




